Do You Take Any of These Drugs?

1. Gabapentin (Neurontin)

- Helps reduce nerve pain by decreasing nerve excitability.
- Side effects: Drowsiness, dizziness, fatigue, swelling in extremities, mood changes.

2. Pregabalin (Lyrica)

- Works similarly to gabapentin, reducing nerve pain by affecting calcium channels in nerve cells.
- Side effects: Dizziness, weight gain, dry mouth, blurred vision, swelling, sleepiness.

3. Duloxetine (Cymbalta)

- An antidepressant that helps with nerve pain.
- Side effects: Nausea, dry mouth, dizziness, insomnia, fatigue, increased sweating.

4. Amitriptyline (Elavil)

- Antidepressant that blocks nerve pain signals to the brain.
- Side effects: Dry mouth, drowsiness, weight gain, constipation, blurred vision, dizziness.

5. Nortriptyline (Pamelor)

- Antidepressant that slows nerve pain transmission.
- Side effects: Drowsiness, dry mouth, dizziness, weight gain, constipation.

6. Carbamazepine (Tegretol)

An anticonvulsant that stabilizes nerve activity and helps with nerve pain

Side effects: Drowsiness, dizziness, nausea, blurred vision, liver toxicity (rare).

7. Oxcarbazepine (Trileptal)

Similar to carbamazepine, it stabilizes nerve cells and reduces pain signals.

Side effects: Dizziness, fatigue, nausea, double vision, coordination problems.

8. Topiramate (Topamax)

An anticonvulsant that can help with neuropathic pain.

Side effects: Drowsiness, tingling in hands/feet, weight loss, difficulty concentrating.

9. Lidocaine Patch (Lidoderm)

A topical anesthetic patch that numbs localized nerve pain.

Side effects: Skin irritation, redness, swelling at the application site.

10. Capsaicin Cream (Qutenza, Zostrix)

From chili peppers, it reduces pain

Side effects: Burning sensation, redness, irritation at the application site.

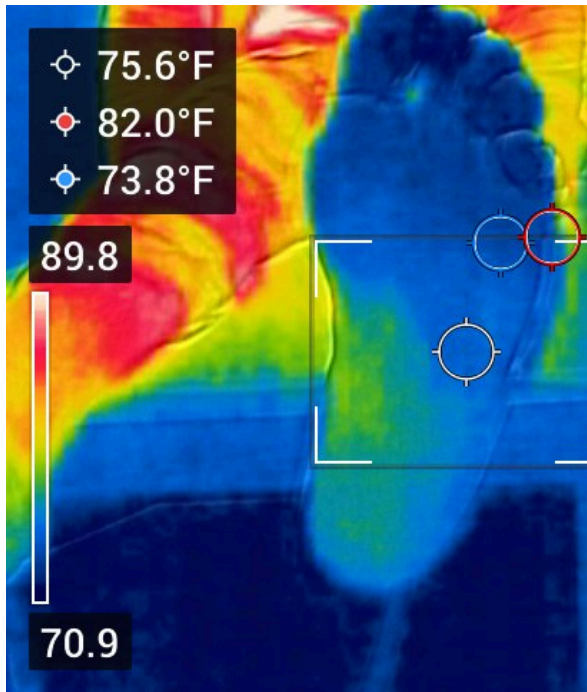

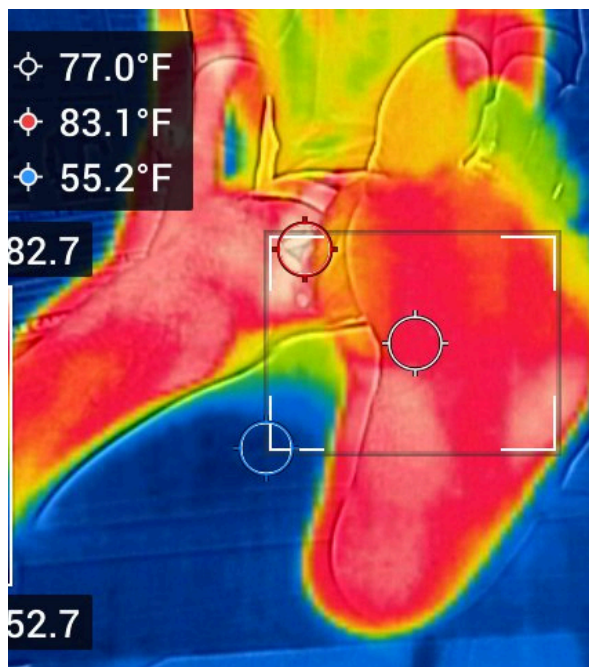
